Attendance & Punctuality

Being in school every day and on time is the single most important part of your child's education. Students learn new things at school every day - missing school puts them behind. If your child misses the start of the day they miss the learning input, information and news for the day.

IN ALL CASES OF ABSENCE parents should please;

Only keep your child away from school if really necessary, we can send them home if they are not well enough to be in school.

Telephone school on the first day to report a child's absence, as early as possible, **before 10.00am**. Avoid medical appointments in school time, but if absolutely necessary, please bring your child to school for the rest of the school day.

The Education Welfare Officer (EWO) inspects the registers once a month and picks up any unauthorised absences/lateness and high numbers of sickness absences, and children with attendance below 90%.
